- 0:33 After you've signed in and navigated to the homescreen, there are two ways that you can access a trainee or apprentice's training contract.
- 0:40 You can click on the 'View trainees or apprentices' button under 'What would you like to do today?' or you can click on 'Trainees and apprentices' in the menu navigation.
- 0:51 Once you've landed on the Trainees or apprentices page, there are three lists available.
- 0:57 Current trainees or apprentices, which are those that have an active training contract.
- 1:03 Past trainees or apprentices, which are training contracts that have been terminated, withdrawn or completed.
- 1:11 And pending training contracts, which are those that are new and are new and are awaiting finalisation.
- 1:16 If you would like to view a training contract and the person is shown in the summary table, simply click on the training contract number.
- 1:27 If the person is not shown on the summary table, click the 'View all' button at the bottom of the table and this will open the full list for your organisation.
- 1:38 Once on this page, you can click on the drop-down list to view past training contracts.
- 1:43 If you know the trainee or apprentice's training number, you can enter that into the search to find their details.
- 1:51 Once you've located the trainee or apprentice, simply click on their 'Training contract number'. This will open their training contract.
- 1:59 The training contract provides you with a summary of their details, the actions you can take, including changing their qualification and exporting their information to a PDF.
- 2:11 In the right column, you'll also be able to see any applications created against this training contract.
