Christie Downs Community Centre Inc	Delivers courses that support students to identify and develop vocational skills of local industries. They provide language, literacy, numeracy, communication and digital skills through digital, culinary, hospitality, cleaning and care courses relevant to local enterprises.

The courses are contextualized to cooking, barista and café work, English language and literacy skills for study and employment, digital skills, horticulture and gardening, communication skills, customer service skills and small business and entrepreneur skills. The project is led by MarionLIFE and run in partnership with City of Marion Neighbourhood Centre and Pasadena Community Centre (City of Mitcham).
Morella Community Centre Inc	Supports students with digital literacy, communication, reading, numeracy and work readiness skills through contextualized courses focusing on beauty services, small businesses, nursing and allied health, and baking.
Multicultural Communities Council of South Australia Inc	Supports culturally and linguistically diverse adults, particularly women, through sewing to build their literacy, numeracy, communication, and digital literacy skills that would be transferable throughout life and work.
Murray Bridge Community Centre Inc	Delivers foundation skills training in Murray Bridge around digital literacy confidence, communication, reading and numeracy skills, foundation skills for employment, introductory small business skills, and learning in everyday environments.
Muslim Women's Association of South Australia Inc	Provides foundation skills training to prepare participants for the workplace including learning English for the workplace, numeracy, digital and oral communication skills, participating in workplace tasks and preparing to engage in workplace tasks.

UnitingSA Ltd	Delivers the "Moving forward pre-employment course" to support student's foundation skills needs including their work readiness skills for training or employment. This course is delivered in three locations: Murray Bridge, Taperoo and Salisbury.
Workers Educational Association of SA Inc	Provides non-accredited short courses to support student's foundation skills training in language, literacy, numeracy, digital literacy, and work readiness.
